## **Publication and Projects**

After conducting my trial as attorney *pro se*, I received permission to appear, again, as attorney *pro se* to argue my federal appeal. I was assisted by appellate lawyer, Charles Bisanz, Jr. *United States Court of Appeals, Eighth Circuit 459 F.2d 697 (1972)*. This appeal was partially published as, "[Resistance as Sacrament](#)" *Cross Currents* (XXI, #4, Fall 1971).
